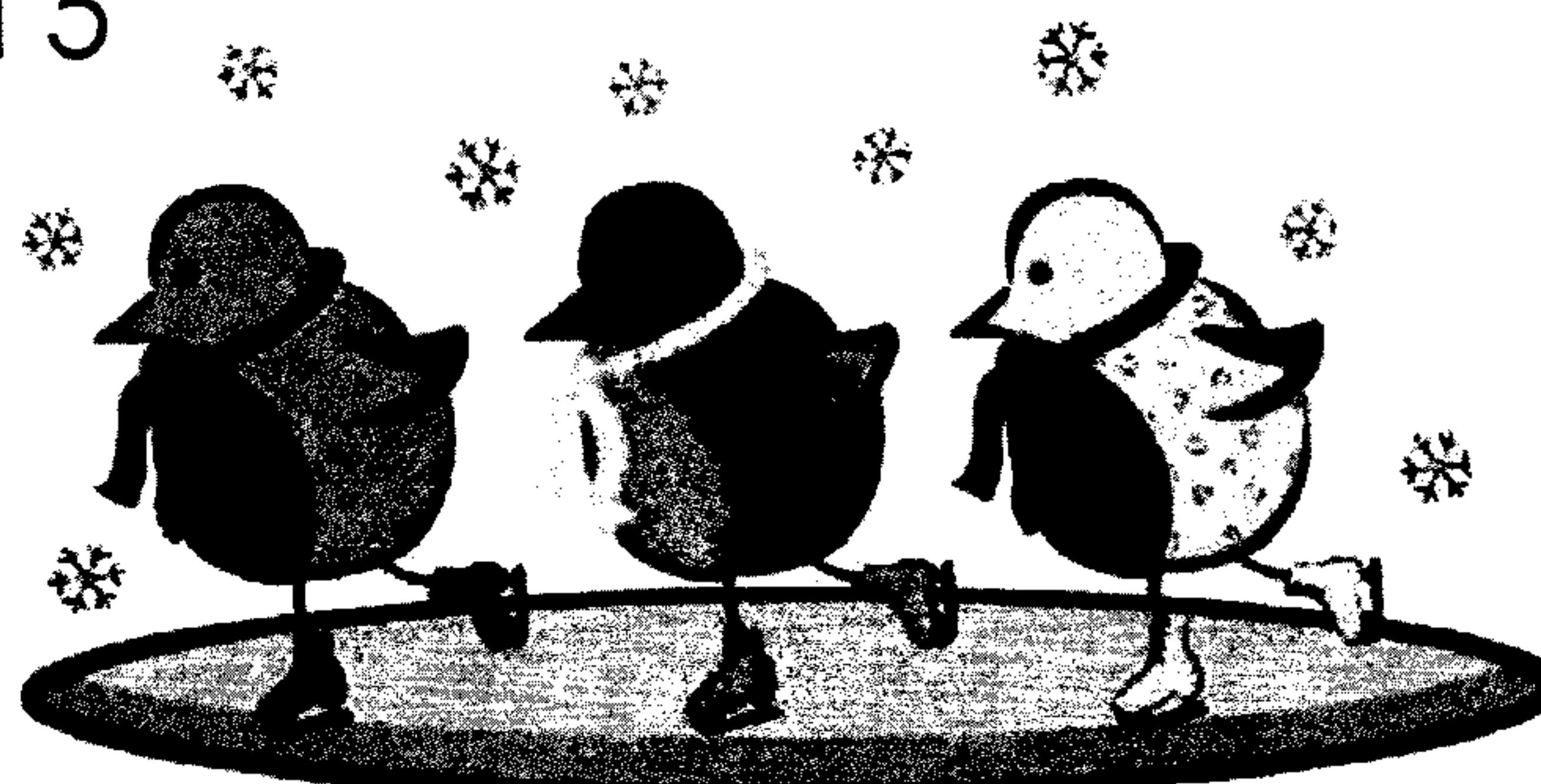

Happy New Year - here's to health and happiness for all! We hope everyone enjoyed the holidays.

First – welcome to new neighbors – Jeremy and Lacey Davis and son, Gunner, new owners of 8 Britten Court. Please be sure to say “hello” and “welcome” when paths cross.

Second – an update on the proposed dues increase. Board members spoke with most homeowners before the holidays. Results were strongly supportive, so the Board will draft the needed amendment in January and start collecting signatures in February.

Winter in Lake Oswego – weather-wise, an erratic time of year. Although it's been relatively mild, the storms are far from over – are you ready? Here are some questions – we hope you have the answers.

#1 – shutoff valves – gas, water, electricity. Do you know where/how/who to call in case of an outage or emergency?

#2 – emergency supplies – flashlights, food, water, medications (for you and your pet). Do you have emergency provisions easily at hand?

#3 – phone numbers – immediate neighbors (look to your right, to your left, across the Court or Terrace). Do you have the current Tanglewood Association roster conveniently at hand?

The City of Lake Oswego issued a Preparedness Guide in November. It includes emergency numbers, explains what (or what not) the City will do in case of an extreme weather event, shows how to turn off that gas valve, and includes websites to visit for information on emergency response.

Of course we hope the mild weather continues, but it's smart to keep informed, have an emergency plan, a basic survival kit *just in case*.
